- Stamina to complete 6.5 hour work day with no nap
- Ability to sit attentively for 15 min.
- Recognize and identify most uppercase and some lower case letters
- Demonstrate basic knowledge of letter-sound correspondence
- Write capital letters
- Ability to write own name
- Able to listen to and follow multi-step directions with adult support
