Reading Language Arts

Story: "Frog and Toad Together"

Guiding Question: What changes happen in a garden?

Amazing Words (vocab): gardener, sprout, nature, dim, shade, sprinkling, destroy, humongous

Phonics: Doubling a final consonant before adding -ed or -ing (example: hop/hopping/hopped); r-controlled vowel -ar (we call this the Pirate Sound)

Sight Words: afraid, again, few, how, read, soon

Comprehension Skills: Author's Purpose (review)
