Reading Language Arts

We are taking a break from our usual reading to focus on zoo animals this week. Last week, we worked on some simple research projects about a favorite animal. We will continue to read non-fiction text and learn more about animals that live in different habitats.

Math

We will be working with time and money this week. Students will be learning to tell time on an analog clock, so this is a great skill to practice at home.
