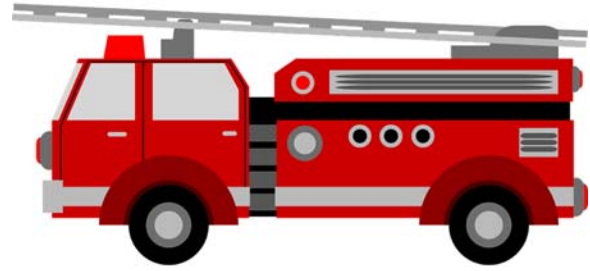
Numbers
