Phonics: Letter i

Our letter this week was the letter i. The children learned the short i sound. Many of our activities were centered learning the i sound. The children are learning to recite the following: **Capital I, little i, i says i (short sound) as in inchworm.** Have the children show you this week's fingerplay: *You bump and you bump as you crawl across the ground. I giggle as you wiggle and you wriggle all around. I like to watch you pinch, then you stretch, and you squirm. You're a funny little caterpillar, Itchy inchworm.*

Next week we will be concentrating on our second vowel. The letter U.

Numbers, Colors, Shapes Review

Much of our week was devoted to reviewing the numbers 1-10, the basic shapes, and ten colors. (pink, red, blue, green, purple, white, brown, black, orange, yellow). Miss Fields has been spending individual time with each student to assess exactly what each student knows and what we need to work on in the upcoming year.
