SGO - AVAILABLE FOR 4 YEAR OLDS (PreK)

Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO) - Good Shepherd Christian Academy partners with the Institute for Quality Education to receive scholarships that make private schools more affordable. These tax credit scholarships are funded by donations. The individuals and businesses that donate to the scholarship receive a tax benefit. Students must be residents of Indiana and their families at least 400% or below the Federal Free and Reduced Lunch Income Guidelines. Students in Kindergarten Prep are eligible. Students may receive both SGO and School Choice funds if tuition and school fees are not exceeded. The awarded amount depends on available funds and will be determined yearly by the school administrator and a school board representative.
